**MAJOR REGULATIONS****PREREQUISITES** ..... Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.**P/NP GRADING OPTION** ..... All courses, including those applied to the major from other departments, must be taken for letter grades.**SUBSTITUTIONS** ..... In the major requirements, permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.**G.P.A. REQUIREMENTS** ..... At least 2.0 overall UC average in **all** upper-division major courses **and** **all** courses (Prep and UD) for the major.**DOUBLE MAJORS** ..... With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
