

Requirements for the minor in PORTUGUESE, 2026-2027

All courses to be applied to the minor must be completed on a letter-grade basis. This includes both courses offered in Portuguese and those offered by other departments and applied to the minor.

PREPARATION

UNITS TO COMPLETE

Portuguese 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 or equivalent 0-24 _____

Note: A grade of “C” or higher is required to progress in lower-division Portuguese courses.

UPPER-DIVISION

20 UD units are required, distributed as follows:

- A. Portuguese 102A 4 _____
- B. Portuguese 145 or 147 4 _____
- C. Portuguese 105 or 105E 4 _____
- D. Portuguese 106 or 106E 4 _____
- E. One UD Portuguese elective course 4 _____

NOTE: Maximum of 4 units may be taken from courses taught in English.
 Additional courses taught in English may count (by petition) if all work is done in Portuguese.

Substitutions and waivers are subject to approval by the chair of the department.

Students must consult the *General Catalog* for prerequisites to required courses.

The following conditions must also be met for official recognition of the minor:

- The sponsoring department reports completion of the minor prior to the posting of the degree.
- At least 18 upper-division quarter units are completed for the minor. (Waivers cannot reduce the requirement below this number.)
- The UC grade-point average in **ALL** applied upper-division courses is 2.0 or higher.
- No more than 5 upper-division units overlap between this minor and the upper-division portion of the major(s) or other minor(s). If overlap is greater with the major(s), completion of the minor will not be formally recognized; if overlap with other minor(s) is greater, only the first minor reported will be recognized.
